Removing the Underlayment

- Removal of old floor tile or vinyl takes up a lot of time, is difficult and leaves behind pieces which don't come off easily.
- A better alternative is to remove the underlayment and the floor covering.
- 1/4 -inch plywood or cement board is also an inexpensive option.



Installing a Curved Shower Rod

- Something as small as a shower rod can add a lot of room to the shower area.
- Shower rods are costlier when compared to straight rods.
- Shower rods are attached to the wall so no worry of them being pulled down.
